PHILIPPINES (MINDANAO) HOSTILE CHRISTIAN PERSECUTION IN PHILIPPINES (MINDANAO)



OVERVIEW: In the Muslimmajority southern island region of Mindanao, Islamist groups and the government have engaged in a longstanding conflict over the

Islamists' desire to form an independent Muslim state. Groups such as Abu Sayyaf and Maute have pledged allegiance to the self-proclaimed Islamic State (ISIS) to gain financial help and recruit foreign fighters. Islamic extremists routinely threaten Christians and have driven many out of Muslim-majority areas. Many pastors and other believers have been killed. However, a significant number of Christians remain in these areas as a bold witness for Christ.

MAJOR RELIGIONS: Most people in the greater Philippines are Christians, but the Mindanao region includes areas with a significant Muslim majority and where Islamic extremism has a strong influence.

PERSECUTOR: In the Mindanao region, Christians are attacked by both Sunni Muslims and communist rebels.

WHAT IT MEANS TO FOLLOW CHRIST IN PHILIPPINES (MINDANAO): In the Mindanao region, attacks on Christians are sporadic and unpredictable, creating an environment of constant tension for Christians. Government forces usually respond when conflicts occur, but Christians' rights are not protected in areas where the government has ceded control to Islamists. Churches are legal, and graduates of Bible schools in the Mindanao region boldly return to share the gospel in their local communities.

ACCESS TO BIBLES: Bibles are available in cities but are much harder to obtain in the most difficult rural areas.

VOM WORK: VOM responds to attacks on Christians and provides tools and training for front-line workers.

PRAYER REQUESTS:

Pray that cross-cultural workers will reach out fearlessly to those in dangerous, unreached areas

Pray for front-line workers Ruth and Mary, beginning work in a new community among the Maquindanao people

Pray that a group of newly baptized believers will stand firm in their faith

Pray for a group of young people who feel called to live and minister among an unreached people group

Pray that a new believer will be able to tell her family about her new life in Christ

Pray that community leaders will welcome front-line workers to their villages

PRISONER NAME: Pastor Meron Gebreselasie

LOCATION: Eritrea ARRESTED: June 2004 HELD: 6,591 DAYS

Pastor Meron Gebreselasie was arrested on June 3, 2004. Meron, also known as Million, was the pastor of Massawa Rhema Evangelical Church in Massawa, a Red Sea port city. He was also an anesthetist at Massawa Hospital.

Meron was arrested shortly after Pastor Tesfatsion Hagos of Asmara, who was arrested on May 27, 2004 while visiting Meron. On his way to return Tesfatsion's belongings to his home in Asmara, Meron was detained at a checkpoint. He has been in prison ever since.

He was held for two months at Asmara's 2nd Police Station before being moved to the maximum-security Wengel Mermera Central Criminal Investigation Interrogation Center, where many of Eritrea's prominent Christian leaders arrested after the 2002 religious crackdown are believed to be held. None have been charged, tried or given prison sentences.

The pastor was not married.
